The SETTING

1. What is the main cause of David's attitude in his Kingdom?
2. What is the result of priorities being out of balance?

The WORDING

1. Using Blueletterbible.org or a concordance, look up the word "comfortably" in the Greek language. Based on that definition, what did David lose with his people?
2. If the wording of verse 4 is a continuation of 2 Samuel 18:33, then how is David losing control of his priorities as king of Israel?

The MEANING

1. Why would David replace Joab with Amasa, and was that a good decision?
2. Why is it important not to make decisions when our emotions are high? Compare Nehemiah 5:6-7.

The LIVING

1. How do we avoid the landslide of character observed in David up to this point? Compare 2 Corinthians 7:10-11.
2. What are some practical steps to getting priorities back in order? Compare Revelation 2:4-5.
