- 1. What water baptism is?
 - a. Water baptism is the outward profession of what has taken place inwardly
 - b. Water baptism is a step of obedience to the word of God
 - c. Water baptism is a public declaration
- 2. What water baptism is not?
 - a. Water baptism is not salvation but evidence of salvation
 - b. Water baptism is not a recurring action but a one-time event
 - c. Water baptism is not changing you but reveals the change in you

- 1. Work on a short testimony to share how the Lord has touched your life and what is leading you to take this step.
- 2. Pray for your water baptism ceremony that it will encourage others to live out their faith publicly.
- 3. Read the following verses to familiarize yourself with what the scriptures say about baptism:
 - a. Matthew 28:19 part of the great commission
 - b. Acts 2:37-41 followed acceptance of salvation in Jesus Christ
 - c. Acts 8:26-38 the next action after accepting the Lord
 - d. Acts 9:17-18 a public profession of faith after receiving a touch of the Lord
 - e. Acts 10:44-48 the next action after being filled with the Holy Spirit
 - f. Acts 16:27-34 the next action after receiving salvation
 - g. 1 Corinthians 1:14-17 mentioned in the epistles
 - h. 1 Peter 3:21 as evidence of what occurred inwardly
