The SETTING

- 1. According to 1 Peter 5:8, why should we be vigilant?
- 2. According to 2 Samuel 10, warfare often arises when? Think about the context in relation to the previous chapters.

The WORDING

- 1. In observing the word "kindness" in verse 2, what can we conclude about the work of grace? Compare Mephibosheth to Hanun.
- 2. In referencing David's men as "mighty" in verse 7, how does this reveal the work of God through David? Compare 1 Samuel 22:2.

The MEANING

- 1. How does verse 5 reveal David's heart as a leader?
- 2. Since David moved only after the enemy moved in verse 7, what character trait did David exhibit after the insult?

The LIVING

- 1. What is the key to vigilance in 1 Peter 5:8? Think about the first two words.
- 2. How should we approach spiritual warfare? Compare Ephesians 6:10.
